

Printing a specific section from a large PDF document.
(Often useful for printing specific areas on PDF versions of maps.)

Zooming to what you want to print

1. Zoom and pan the document so the area you want to print is fitting into your window.

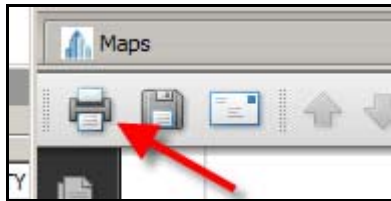
Printing – depends on how you are viewing the PDF document.

2a. If you are viewing the PDF document with Acrobat Reader (i.e., not inside a web browser window) then:

- Select the menu “File > Print Setup” if needed, to set margins and such on your print device.
- Select the menu “File > Print” to begin the printing process.

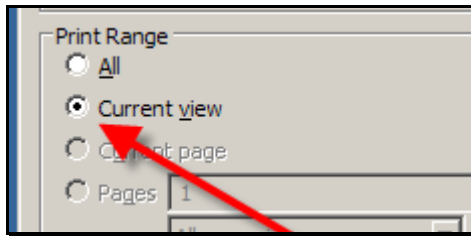
2b. If you are viewing the PDF document within a web browser window, then:

- Select the “Print” icon from inside your web browser window:



3. In the “Print Range” section of the “Print” dialog, choose “Current View.”

- This tells Acrobat you want to print only what you currently see of the PDF document.



4. Optionally, choose “Page Scaling” to your liking.

- Note: “Fit to Printable Area” will make the maximum use of the selected paper size. It will scale your “Current view” up or down as needed to fit the paper.
